Pre School Around the World

Beginning in January 2010 we will be offering Pre school around the world. This is an opportunity for students to extend their day and learn about cultures around the world. This class is taught by **Meredith Spivy** and Charlene Harmon.

Little Performers A number of our students also take dance lessons at the building through Little Performers (formerly Veba School of Dance). They learn ballet, tap, folk, tumbling, movement, and song, and perform in a recital.

Fundraising

Bright Beginnings is a child centered, family-focused preschool committed to developing and preparing the whole child for learning and their transition into Kindergarten



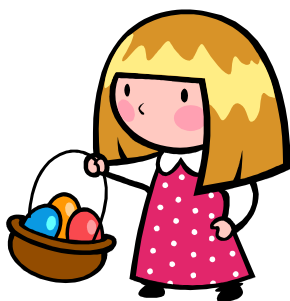
